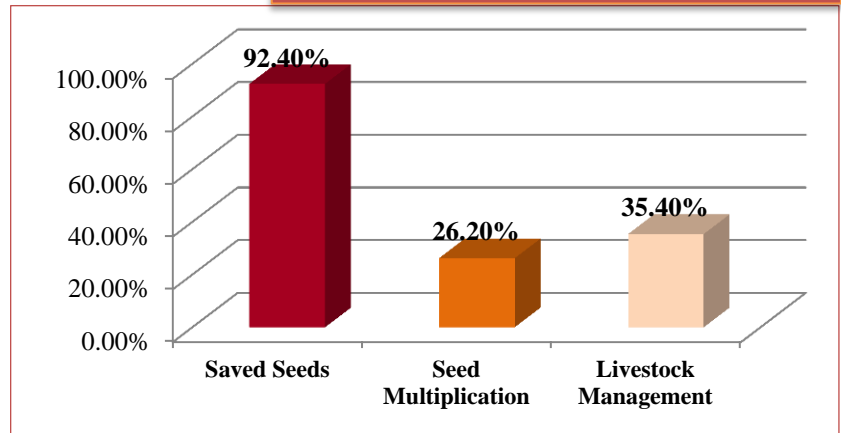

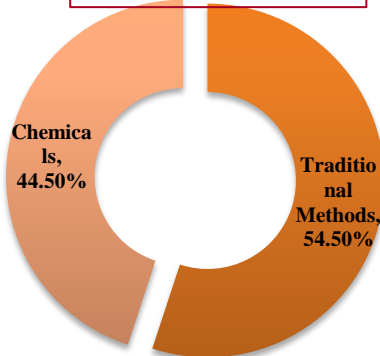

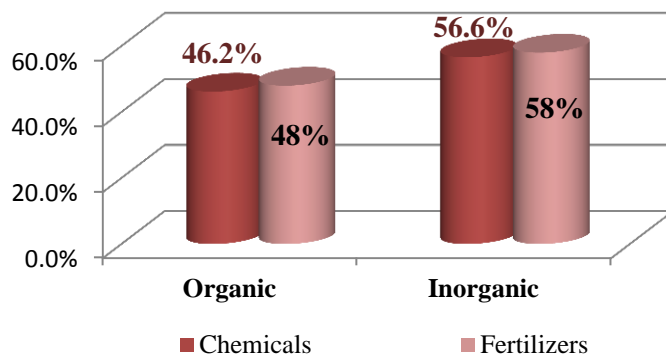
PESTS AND DISEASE CONTROL

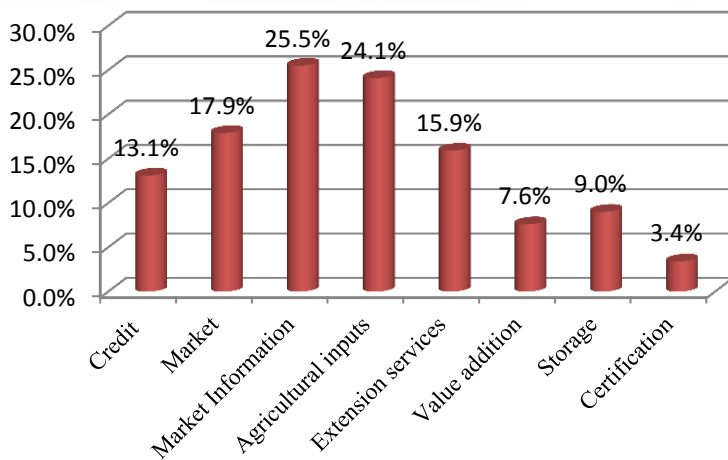

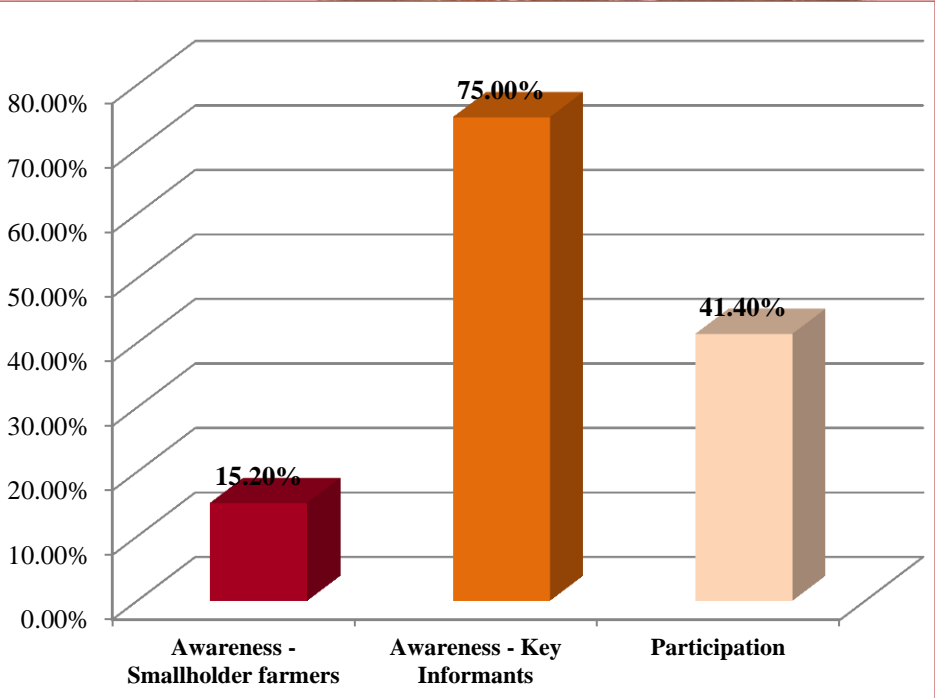
